

Annual Report Fiscal Year 2023-2024

Board meetings are held on the third Saturday of each month at the Hope Brown Center, Farnham Farm.

The public is invited to attend and comment. At present, the Board is implementing projects to improve the quantity and quality of our water. Your opinions and suggestions enhance the discussion.

System Improvements

The Rhode Island Department of Health has given final approval for a treatment facility that should improve the coliform, iron, and manganese water quality issues. The construction contract has been awarded to Biszko, and funding of approximately \$3.8 million is being finalized with the Rhode Island Infrastructure Bank.

Water lines in Bristol Colony have been replaced, with site restoration to occur in the spring of 2025. These line replacement projects are primarily funded by Congressionally Directed Spending grants.

The PIWD continues work on overall system reliability. An automatic generator was installed at the Broadway booster facility, and exterior maintenance was completed.

The PIWD bought a replacement truck.

Cross Connection Control

The State requires the PIWD to implement a Cross Connection Control Plan. Licensed surveyors have completed reports for all properties.

Through the coming years, the PIWD will be adding, removing, and replacing backflow preventers installed at some curb stops. This work may disrupt individual customer service lines.
